CURRICULUM NEWS

Turbo Tables

This new initiative is certainly encouraging pupils to up their maths skills. Turbo Tables focuses on embedding times tables and division knowledge by gradually speeding up recall. The children have to answer 36 questions in 3 minutes and build up to doing it in one minute. Eventually they move on to fractions and decimals linked to the tables they are on. They earn certificates to encourage them. Everyone is working at their own pace to improve their own attainment.

Fortnightly Focus - Whole School

Week 7,8 - Resilience In accordance with the national government's concern over poor resilience in children, we will be setting up little challenges in and around school. We are aiming to increase their 'problem solving toolbox'. Let Redhill buck this national trend...by making our children resilient, strong, resourceful, independent thinkers and doers!
